

The Wellbeing in Mind Team are an NHS early intervention service Mental Health Support Team. We run groups in school, to support children's wellbeing, helping them to develop their skills with friendships, managing emotions, and lots more! We can also do 1:1 work with children in year 5 and 6 and with parents of children of all year groups. Over the next half term, we will be joining some assemblies, running some groups, delivering some staff training, and popping along to some school events. If you have any questions or concerns about your child's mental health or wellbeing, please free to chat to us if you see us, or speak to someone in school in the first instance, who will then liaise with us as appropriate.
