Our School Day

Fidgets

Over the past few months at school, the use of 'fidgets' has become overwhelming within the classroom.

For this reason, from September, no fidgets will be allowed to be brought in from home.

The school has now followed educational guidance on the effectiveness of these and has bought a box of approved fidgets for each class which will be available for children at the teachers discretion. This rule will also apply to any other toys/teddies brought into school unless prearranged with the class teacher.

We are delighted to let you know that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will receive a brand new red book bag in September! It will be compulsory to bring this to school everyday with your child's reading record and book inside. You could also pop any spare clothes/hats/suncream in here if you need to. Children will not need to bring any other bag to school unless they require a pack up. We thank you for your support with this.

Reading Stars

Watch out for our brand new 'READING STARS' reward system in September! Your child will have a special bookmark in their reading record with stars to collect for reading books (KS1) and chapters (KS2) with rewards to aim towards!



Healthy Snacks

To support our students' concentration, energy, and overall well-being, we are strengthening our commitment to healthy snacks at breaktimes and within school.

This will mean that all chocolate and sweets will no longer be allowed, both in pack ups and at breaktime. We also ask that a small bag of crisps is kept for lunch time only.

More suitable options are as follows:

Vegetable sticks, fresh or dried fruit, calcium-rich cheese.

For a slow-release energy boost: plain breadsticks, pretzels, oat/rice cakes, small pitta breads, malt loaf, or banana bread are also fantastic choices.
